Paradise for Fishermen

The mangrove estuary is one of the Earth's richest and most diversified marine environments. A place where fresh and sait water mix, estuaries support a complex web of life both above and below the water line. Countles javenile fish and inwertebrates thrive in its underwater nursery. Crabs and snails climb the roots and branches of the mangrove trees and become food for the birds and land mammals that inhabit the islands. 




