Another idea is to write a heartfelt letter. Don't let another year pass without letting your mom know how much you love her. Letters seem "old fashioned" but they are truly one of the most personal ways to honor someone you love.

What you do is up to you. What's most important is to let your mom know how important she is to you and your family.



SAWFISH NEWS by Tonya Wiley, Havenworth Coastal Conservation Sawfish At-Home Education and Entertainment Resources

Normally this Sawfish News article shares information about sawfish research, management, and policy. But due to COVID-19, these aren't normal times. Schools are closed, most of us are under safer-at-home orders and self-isolating directives. So, I'm dedicating this Sawfish News article to sharing information about the many organizations which have sawfish-related educational and entertainment resources for students, teachers, parents, families, and adults during the school closures and stay-at-home orders.

The Sawfish Conservation Society is dedicated to connecting the world to advance global sawfish education, research, and conservation. They have games, coloring pages, lesson plans, crafts, hands-on activities and much more available at http:// sawfishconservationsociety.org/.

NOAA Fisheries is the agency responsible for the protection and recovery of the endangered smalltooth sawfish population in the United States. You can learn about the targeted management actions taken to recover this species at https:// www.fisheries.noaa.gov/species/smalltooth-sawfish. To learn more about sawfish research, management, and conservation in the United States visit www.SawfishRecovery.org.

The IUCN Shark Specialist Group developed a Global Sawfish Conservation Strategy in 2014 that provides an update on the status of sawfishes, and details global-scale prioritized recommendations for meaningful research, education and conservation action and a roadmap for the development of regional conservation programs to improve the global status of sawfishes. Also available on their website https://www.iucnssg.org/conservation-strategiessawfish.html are regional fact sheets and other infographics.

Sharks4Kids is creating a new generation of shark advocates through access to a dynamic range of educational materials including sawfish (and shark) webinars, a "What is a Sawfish" curriculum Power Point, coloring sheet, fact sheet, and more sawfish, shark, and ray information on their website https://www.sharks4kids.com/.

Sharks and Rays Australia is conducting an assessment of the current distributions and abundance patterns of four species of sawfishes in Australia and has sawfish identification guides, sawfish craft ideas, coloring sheets, and a sawfish food web game at https:// www.sharksandraysaustralia.com/materials/#outreach

International Sawfish Day is celebrated each year on October 17 to raise awareness for sawfish around the world and to highlight the threats they face in order to safeguard their future. The website https://internationalsawfishday.org/ has education and entertainment resources for use every day including posters, coloring pages, activities, and infographics in English, Spanish, Portuguese, and Arabic.

Taxing Things by Mike the Tax Guy

IRS Economic Relief Efforts

Stimulus Payments:

► If you filed a 2018 or 2019 tax return and received your refund by direct deposit, the IRS will use that bank information to distribute your payment.

► If you receive Social Security by direct deposit, that bank information will be used.

► If you have not filed a return for 2018 or 2019, you will need to access the IRS tool for 'Non-Filers' to provide bank information.

► If you filed 2018 or 2019 tax return and owed a payment by direct withdrawal, that bank information will NOT be used. Instead you must also access the 'Non-Filers' tool to provide information.

► If you do not have a bank account and have filed with the 'Non-Filers' tool, you will receive a check by mail; however, much later than direct deposit.

Economic Injury Disaster Loan Assistance Program

This program is for any small business with less than 500 employees, including sole proprietorships, independent contractors and self-employed persons.

Residents can complete the application at home and mail it.



School News for Parents CCPS Kindergarten Registration is Online Here is How to Get Started

Collier County Public Schools is excited to announce that student registration is now completely done through our Online Centralized Registration platform. This eliminates the need for visiting district sites in person to finalize registration.

Kindergarten Registration for the 2020-21 school year will begin on **Monday**, **May 4**, 2020. The child must be five years old on or before September 1, 2020, to register for Kindergarten. To register, please follow the steps outlined below.

STEP 1: GATHER REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Go to https://visitevergladescity.com/kregistration/ and download the list of REQUIRED documents for student registration. All of the applicable listed documents MUST be submitted in order to complete the registration process.

STEP 2: COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION ONLINE

Visit **register.collierschools.com** to access the Online Centralized Registration system to complete student registration.

STEP 3: CHECK THE STATUS OF YOUR REGISTRATION

Visit **register.collierschools.com** for access to the status of a student registration application.
